Roll Call:

Bathhouse Stabilization Project:

Council received one bid for the Bathhouse Stabilization project which was received and publicly opened on September 18, 2024 at 2:00 P.M. Alfero Co., Inc submitted the following: Base Bid for General Construction, \$411,858.00, Add Alternate 1 for Berger #100 Snow Guards, \$127,485.00, and Add Alternate 2, replace all concrete paving in front of basement level overhead door. Concrete to include concrete slab, associated cheek walls, and full width trench drain, \$19,888.00. Solicitor Peter Layman reviewed the Bid Bond and found it to be in order. Councilwoman Tammy Kemp made a motion to award the base bid and add alternate two (2) to Alfero Co., Inc, seconded by Councilwoman Joann Anderson. Unanimous by roll call.

Councilwoman Tammy Kemp made a motion to direct Solicitor Peter Layman to notify Teamster Local 773 that Pen Argyl Borough Council upholds the decision of Borough Manager/Treasurer Robin Zmoda's response on September 10, 2024 to deny William Parr's grievance of his termination of his employment with the Borough of Pen Argyl on September 6, 2024, and to reject Teamster Local 773's counter offer to restore the employment of Mr. Parr, utilizing the time of termination until restatement as a suspension without pay for the offense of insubordination seconded by Councilwoman Josephine Hildabrant. Unanimous by roll call.
